A Princely Indian State Postage Stamps, 1869 to 1950


Purpose and Scope: This is a traditional exhibit showing the development of the princely Indian state of Hyderabad postage stamps from the first issue of 8 September 1869 to the last issue of 1949. The last postage stamp issues of Hyderabad were in use until 1950.

Background: Unlike 39 other Indian princely states that issued postage stamps, Hyderabad was a prosperous princely state. It had the largest population of any princely state, the second largest territory after Kashmir and was the third princely state to issue postage stamps after Soruth (1864) and Jammu & Kashmir (1866). For the first 67 years of its postage stamp issuing time period its postage stamps were engraved printed (recess) and except for two temporary issues the printing plates were produced by firms in London. During this 67 year period the stamps were printed and perforated in Hyderabad.

A distinguishing feature of Hyderabad's prosperity is the size of their sheets of stamps. The first issue of Hyderabad is a engraved sheet of 160 stamps while the largest known multiple of Soruth's first issue is a handstamped strip of three and Jammu & Kashmir is a handstamped single circular stamp. Hyderabad's second and third issues are also engraved plates but containing 240 stamps
